

ANNUAL PERMIT STATUS REPORT

Definitions

“Surface Mining” means any activity constituting all or part of a process for the removal of minerals, ores, and other solid matter for sale or for processing or for consumption in the regular operation of a business. Tunnels, shafts and dimension stone quarries shall not be considered to be surface mining.

Disturbed Land -

- Lands that are open pits, overburden dumps and haul or access roads, sediment basins, etc., that have not begun to be shaped into a land form for final reclamation.
- Those lands that meet the requirements so that the State could release the lands if so requested, but for various reasons a release has not been formally applied for.
- Those lands that have had land form grading started but are not reclaimed to the point where the State would release them if so requested.

Released - Reclaimed lands and/or lands approved through amendments to be released by the State.

Undisturbed Land - Permitted land that has not been disturbed and will be used for future mining.
