BACKGROUND

On October 17, 2007, Packaging Corporation of America, Inc (hereafter PCA) submitted an application for an air quality permit to install a recovery furnace and associated smelt dissolving tank (proposed No. 4 Recovery Furnace and No. 4 Smelt Dissolving Tank). PCA will also shut down the existing No. 1 and No. 2 Recovery Furnaces and associated smelt dissolving. The facility is located at 5495 Lake Park-Clyattville Road in Valdosta, Lowndes County.

On June 17, 2008, the Division issued a Preliminary Determination stating that the modifications described in Application No. 17736 should be approved. The Preliminary Determination contained a draft Air Quality Permit for the construction and operation of the modified equipment.

The Division requested that PCA place a public notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the area of the existing facility notifying the public of the proposed construction and providing the opportunity for written public comment. Such public notice was placed in *Valdosta Daily Times* (legal organ for Lowndes County) on June 20, 2008. The public comment period expired on July 21, 2008.

During the comment period, there were no comments received from the U.S. EPA region IV, the facility or the general public.
