The Environmental Protection Division has completed its review of your application for a Case-by-Case MACT determination in order to operate a coal-fired power plant facility located in Hilton, Georgia (Early County) and has prepared the attached draft air quality Permit. You have the opportunity to provide comments on this draft Permit prior to the expiration of the public comment period indicated below.

By no later than June 24, 2009, the attached Public Notice is to be published **once** by LS Power Development, LLC in *Early County News* (legal organ for Early County). **You must notify Lynn Rhodes at [lynn\\_rhodes@dnr.state.ga.us](mailto:lynn_rhodes@dnr.state.ga.us) at least 7 days prior to publication** providing the date on which the Public Notice will be published. FAILURE TO PROVIDE THE DIVISION THIS 7-DAY ADVANCE NOTICE MAY RESULT IN EPD REQUIRING YOU TO REPUBLISH THE PUBLIC NOTICE. A tear sheet of the Public Notice, showing the date of publication, must be submitted to my attention within 7 days following the date of publication. The "tear sheet" is the entire actual page from the newspaper in which the Public Notice is published.

The draft Air Quality Permit and associated documents will be placed on our web site 30 days from the date of this letter or shortly after you notify us of the date of publication of the Public Notice, whichever is sooner.
