Longleaf Energy Associates, LLC is assigned Application No. 19706 for an air quality permit amendment in order to operate a nominal 1,200 megawatt (MW) coal fired generation station. The Georgia Environmental Protection Division – Air Protection Branch has conducted a permit review and has issued a draft amendment to Longleaf's Air Quality permit adding practically enforceable permit conditions making the facility a minor source for HAPs and extending the commencement of construction and completion dates.

Enclosed is a copy of the public notice concerning the proposal. The public notice concerning the permit amendment and will appear in *Early County News* (legal organ for Early County) by LS Power Development, LLC no later than June 2, 2010. This notice is issued pursuant to State and Federal air quality regulations.
